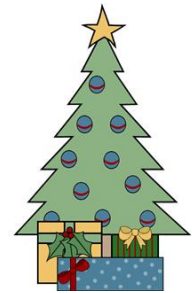

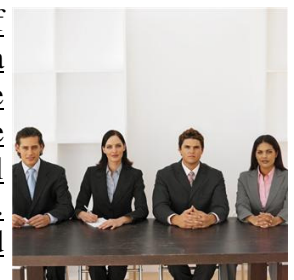
We Want You!

Board Meeting Dates

November 12th

December 10th

The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM on October 10th in the Countryside Recreation Room. The Board reviewed and approved the September minutes and the Treasurer's Report. The front office computer was purchased and data from the old computer was transferred to the new computer. Bids are being excepted for a new computer program to sign members into the Center. There will be three open seats on the Board for the January 2013 Election. Paul Reed and John Glavin agreed to run again if there are no Board candidates for the January Election. Dan Ligocki will not be able to run again. Esteban Roberts who is a new member of the Association and present at the Board meeting informed the Board that he would like to run. The Board agreed to close the Hughes Federal Credit Union account. The Board decided that the Center will be closed on Christmas Eve, Christmas day, New Years Eve and New Years Day. Paul Reed updated the Board on the pool umbrellas. The Board reviewed bids from American Play Systems for repairing the shade screen over the playground and a bid for installing a shade screen on the small playground. Mr. Roberts said he would get the name of the company that did the shade screen at Arthur Pack playground.
