January Board Meeting Recap

The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM on January 15, 2013 in the Countryside Recreation Room. The Board reviewed and approved the December minutes and the Treasurer's Report. Terry Smith continues to work on the new front desk "member sign-in" program. Saguaro Pools will begin work on the pool deck starting the end of January. The cost is \$35,000, which will come from the pool deck reserve fund. The issue of the small playground was tabled until next month. The nominating committee was appointed for 2013, Kelsey Glavin, John Glavin and Mary Dickerson. The Board reviewed two member comment forms. The first member requested that the fitness room open at 6:00AM. The Board felt that would not be cost effective. The other member requested that skate boards be allowed at the Center. This policy change could affect club insurance rates. Request was denied.

Important Notice Regarding Guest Admission

Each household is given 60 guest passes per year beginning in January. Members are responsible for their guest behavior while they are at the Club. Guests have to be accompanied by a member while at the Club, if the member leaves the guest must also leave. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult. Children 10 - 17 must have a written parental consent form on file and can only bring up to 2 guests per child, adults can bring up to 9 guests. A guest of a member child must also have a parent consent form on file. These forms are available at the Countryside office or you can print one from the CCCA website.


