Thru June 2023: YTD income was \$233,468.76 & YTD expenses were \$214,060.97.

Highlights:

- Delinquencies thru June 2023; \$18,406.38.

- Roof over pool locker rooms was repaired, rec room, locker & office roofs were recoated.
- Both coolers & ceilings in the men's & women's locker rooms were repaired due to water leak/damage.
- Light fixtures were replaced in both the men's & women's locker rooms.

- Roadrunner Paving completed the parking lot resurfacing on June 6th.


